Dear Parents and Carers


Thank you for your support this term in helping the College be as safe as it can be during the Covid pandemic. Students are behaving and adapting very well to the new rules, but your continued support in reinforcing the importance of face masks, hand sanitising and social distancing would be appreciated, and will allow us to remain fully open for face to face teaching next half term.

We have had relatively few cases of positive tests for Covid in the college, but each case can be disruptive to all those who need to self isolate. We are supporting these students by a mix of online learning, attending the lessons virtually or by live streaming. It would be good if you could check with your son or daughter that they can access Teams, Moodle and Tyber, so that they are prepared if they are told to self isolate.

You may have heard in the news that exams are being delayed this year for both GCSEs and A Levels. This has resulted in some changes to the end of the academic year. The last exams will take place on 2 July 2021 and so year 13 students should not plan to go away before that date. Year 12 students will end their academic year on Tuesday 6 July 2021 and prospective students who are in year 11 will hopefully be invited into the College for one day between 7 – 9 July 2021 for Welcome to College day.
