

English Literature

In the first year of the course the focus is on the genre of tragedy - the texts are Othello, a selection of Keats' narrative poems (Lamia, Isabella, The Eve of St. Agnes and La Belle Dame Sans Merci) and Arthur Miller's 'Death of a Salesman'. Othello and Keats are both widely available for free online, so we would suggest reading those.

However, wider reading is also a great thing for Literature students to undertake, so **any** 'quality' literature would be worth reading. How about trying to read 3 good novels over the summer, for example?
