

Year 12 Art - Initial studies.

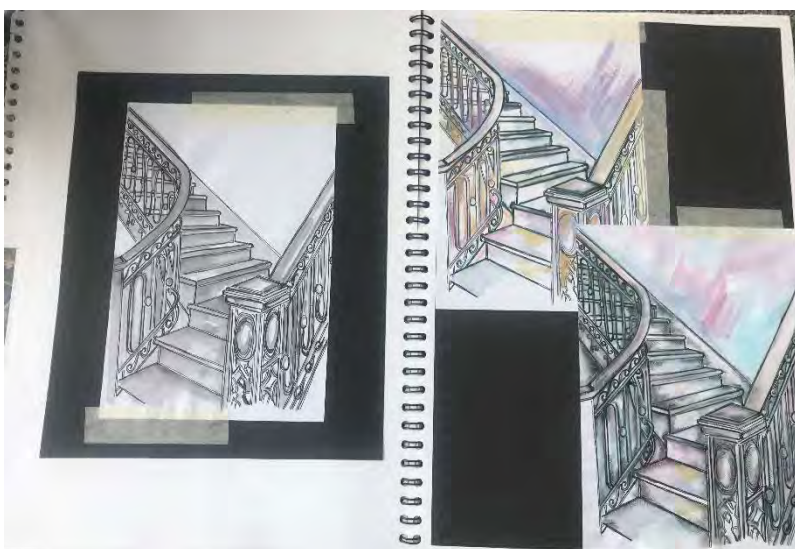
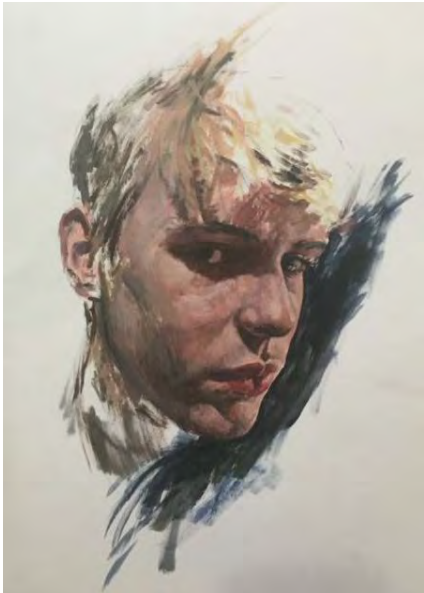
Select from one of the following themes:
