## PROGRAMME OF STUDY AND ENTRY CRITERIA

### For a 3 A level programme:

- At least two grade 6s at GCSE.
- At least a further three grade 4s at GCSE.
- You should have at least a grade 4 in GCSE English Language **AND** Mathematics.

### For a BTEC National Diploma plus 1 A level/A level equivalent programme:

- At least two grade 6s at GCSE or merits on an equivalent course.
- At least a further three grade 4s at GCSE or equivalent.
- You should have at least grade 4 in GCSE English Language **AND** Mathematics.

### For a BTEC Extended Diploma/CACHE programme:

- At least two grade 6s at GCSE or merits on an equivalent course.
- At least a further three grade 4s at GCSE or equivalent.
- You should have at least grade 4 in GCSE English Language **OR** Mathematics, with at least grade 3 in the other one. A GCSE re-sit **must** be done in English Language **OR** Maths.

Some of our most able and ambitious students may wish to study 4 A level subjects. These students must have at least five grade 7s at GCSE and at least a grade 6 in GCSE English Language and Mathematics.

## APPLYING

**STEP 1:** Visit [solihullsf.ac.uk/applying](http://solihullsf.ac.uk/applying). Create an account - then login and complete your application.

**STEP 2:** We will send you confirmation that your application has been received within two weeks.

**STEP 3:** We will contact your school for a reference.

**STEP 4:** If your application indicates you will meet our entry criteria, we will email you to invite you to an interview. At the interview we will discuss your application and your subject choices. Interviews are allocated on a 'first come, first served' basis, so please do not worry if there is a delay in arranging your appointment.

**STEP 5:** All being well, we will make you a written offer of a place at the College. We will ask you to confirm your acceptance of the offer.

**STEP 6:** You will be invited to attend our Welcome to College Day event, where you can get a taste of College life. Attendance at this event is compulsory.

**STEP 7:** We will write to you over the summer with details about enrolment, which will take place after GCSE results are known. It is crucial that you attend enrolment on the date and time specified. Failure to attend enrolment can put your place at the College at risk. After enrolment, your studies will begin. The deadline for all applications is 31 March 2022.
